**All-New Health Services Coming to the Sweet Home Community**

Residents and Visitors to Have A New Choice in Healthcare

**Sweet Home, OR -- July 20, 2021:** Sweet Home and the surrounding communities will soon have a comprehensive new choice in healthcare. Sweet Home Clinic, located at 1023 South Main Street, is set to open its doors in August 2021.

The community has grown substantially in recent years, prompting the need for additional primary care providers. Bridging the gap to better local healthcare, while meeting the community's demand for greater access to health professionals, Sweet Home Clinic will provide services seven days a week, every day of the year, with extended daily hours.

"Our approach is to treat people, not patients," says Dr. Sam Milstein, urgent care physician and CEO of Sweet Home Clinic. "Our team is committed to treating the community with long-overdue dignity, compassion, and respect. We will address each patient's unique needs efficiently, without sacrificing quality of care."

Thanks to modern technology, Sweet Home Clinic will maximize its availability of services, improve communication, and facilitate a convenient patient experience, Dr. Milstein explains. An eight-room, 5,000 square foot facility has been remodeled into a comfortable, relaxed, and unrushed environment. The new clinic will initially offer urgent care services on both a walk-in and appointment basis, followed by X-ray imaging services later this year, and all primary care services no later than December 2021. Along with access, affordability is key.

"We're very sensitive to the cost of healthcare," Dr. Milstein stresses. "While we take most insurance plans, we're also here for folks visiting out-of-network and those without coverage. We will provide significantly discounted services and affordable payment plans for anyone paying out of pocket."

Available procedures will include everything from basic wound care, breathing treatments, and skin tag/cyst removals, to injections, contraception, STI screenings, and more. Telehealth services will be available upon request, and all patients will have online access to records, test results, and staff communication.
